**I Update on 2023 Legislative Package**

**H 0070 -- County Indigent Services - HB735 clean up**  
Headed for the Governor's office for his signature.

**H 0194 - Yoga fee**  
The bar keeps getting raised on how much we have to do to get a hearing. The sponsors keep working on breaking down that bar. We need a majority of Republicans to support this so we can get a hearing. Need to let party and youth prevention.

**H 0081 DMV Fee Fine**  
Headed for the Governor's office for his signature.

**I. Near Business**

**H 0181 Property Tax No Provision - Opposed (Johak)**  
Still working with legislators to get a compromise bill.

**H 0234 Public Defense Update**  
The bill was heard in the House Judiciary and Rules committee and was sent to the House floor with a dual pass recommendation. Staff is working with House members to make sure there are the votes to get it to the Senate. What are the concerns? The attorneys are worried there won't be enough funding and they don't like the bill down structure. They believe there should be more local control. There is a lot of local control built in and this is what the Governor's office has agreed to. What about contract attorneys? There is no intent to remove anyone. There are not enough attorneys out there to replace all the contract attorneys. It has always been stated that the intent was to continue to have a mix of local control attorneys.

Clarifies that County Sheriffs no longer receive salaries included in the post-election audit. The amended bill will be received by the County Clerk. If failure to account, following a post-election audit, the salaries are to be turned over to the sheriff's county. The post-election audit must, at minimum, include a hard count of the ballots subject to audit and a comparison to the results reported by the county.

**Bill Summary:**  
This legislation provides revisions due to the issue of the Catastrophe Health Care Program and the county indigent program. It outlines the current policy for jail medical claims that was reported last session in HB735. It also gives a path forward for settlement requests for approved indigent claims. Currently the Catastrophe Health Care Fund receives \$5.00 of every vote and fee. Since the bill fund and board will be replaced, this legislation sends the \$5.00 through the existing formula distributed in the county district fund, the state general fund, the highway distribution account, the state public school account fund, and to POST. Leads the legislation reveals the CDF fund account but amends the Catastrophe Health Care Fund until the end of September 2023 to allow for the completion of the audit and annual reports.

Under this bill, the STATE Criminal Justice Commission is required to improve the state, county, and municipal paper data system. The Commission is required to publish the data system on its website as an electronic format accessible to the public. Beginning on January 1, 2024, and unless prohibited by any other law, criminal justice agencies in STATE are required to submit specified data into the system. The Commission is required to establish policies to protect confidential information. The bill appropriates \$4.7 million in FY2023-24, \$4.6 million in FY2024-25, and \$4.8 million in FY2025-26 from the state general fund to the Commission to implement the data system. "Criminal justice agency" (as defined by SSIC CODE) means a court or any governmental unit with criminal or equivalent jurisdiction, including courts of any foreign sovereignty duly recognized by the federal government. [STAT CODE], which ranges on Page 4, Line 27 of the bill and ends on Page 5, line 29. Some of the information required to be provided, courts may not have, and at times, will not have, for instance (1) whether an individual is documented, and date of death; (2) an individual's physical gender and sex; (3) any alias the individual may have had; (4) the county where the individual was arrested; (5) the mailing address for the individual; further, the bill requires disclosure of information in relation to every single event that takes place in an entire case that just the final (disposition) disposition; (1) the type and date of any motion filed; (2) the type of any hearing and date. In any single case there are many events and proceedings that take place. Establishing systems to generate and report this data comes with a cost to every court in the state, and reporting obligations will be imposed on the state. The sponsors of this bill have not considered these costs that will be incurred by the "reporting" courts. If this bill is passed and signed by the Governor, the development of systems and processes, including IT systems and processes, to comply with the requirements for being an attorney in good standing in the state other than filing the opening and closing of attorney files on the STATE Supreme Court. This bill, in its current form, is opposed because of the data it requires courts to report, where certain such data courts will not have.

The bill moves the requirement for licensing attorneys to the Supreme Court of STATE directly and also replaces all areas in the STATE Bar rules that require people to be members of the State Bar of STATE in order to qualify to be licensed attorneys in the state. The bill also moves the duty of disclosing any disciplinary matters against attorneys and for compensating attorneys who prevail against charges in disciplinary proceedings. This bill appears to have the intent of removing and effectively removing the authority of the State Bar of STATE (and any other prospective private organization with the same mission, purpose) and instead placing regulation entirely to the STATE Supreme Court. It's unclear whether the text of the bill as written would remove the State Bar of STATE's ability to investigate and conduct disciplinary matters, as the language doesn't expressly remove that but instead appears to rely on the idea that the bar can't regulate anyone who isn't a member. The bill also does not ban the Bar, as it's unclear if it would create separate disciplinary oversight bodies for attorneys depending on whether they are members of the Bar or not. The bill does not change the requirements for licensing nor does it say what they should be, so finally it doesn't necessarily change the requirements for being an attorney in good standing in the state other than shifting the oversight and licensing of attorneys from the Bar to the STATE Supreme Court.
