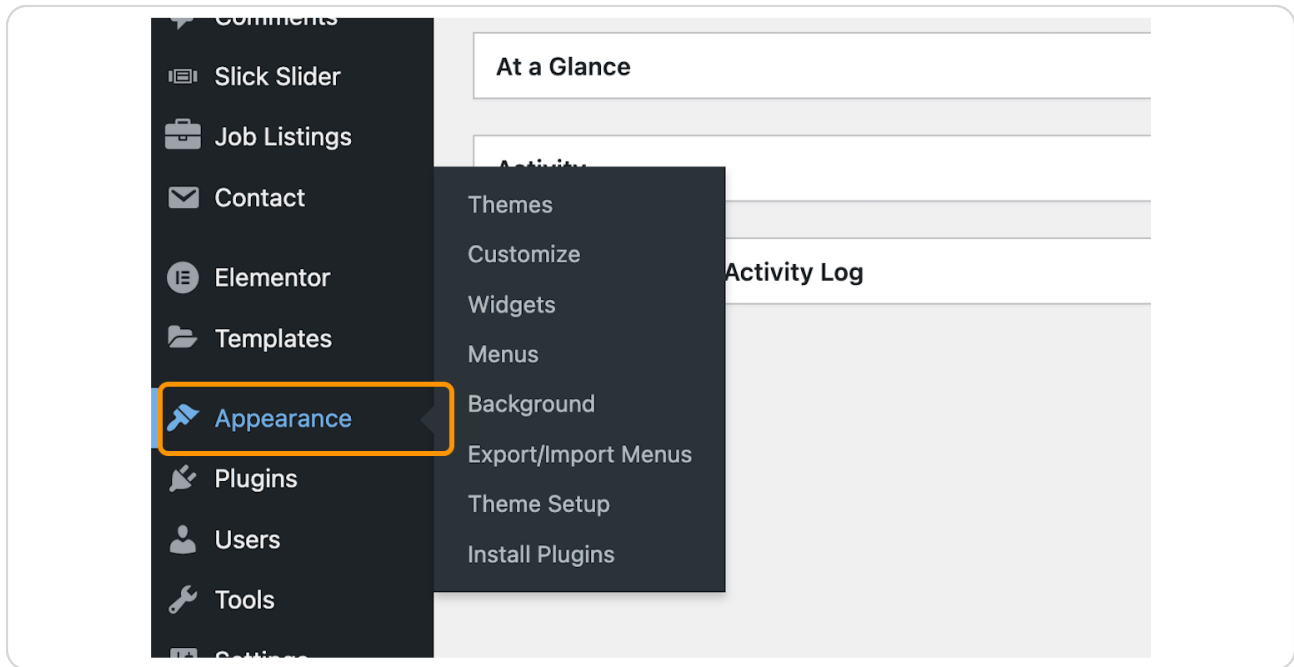
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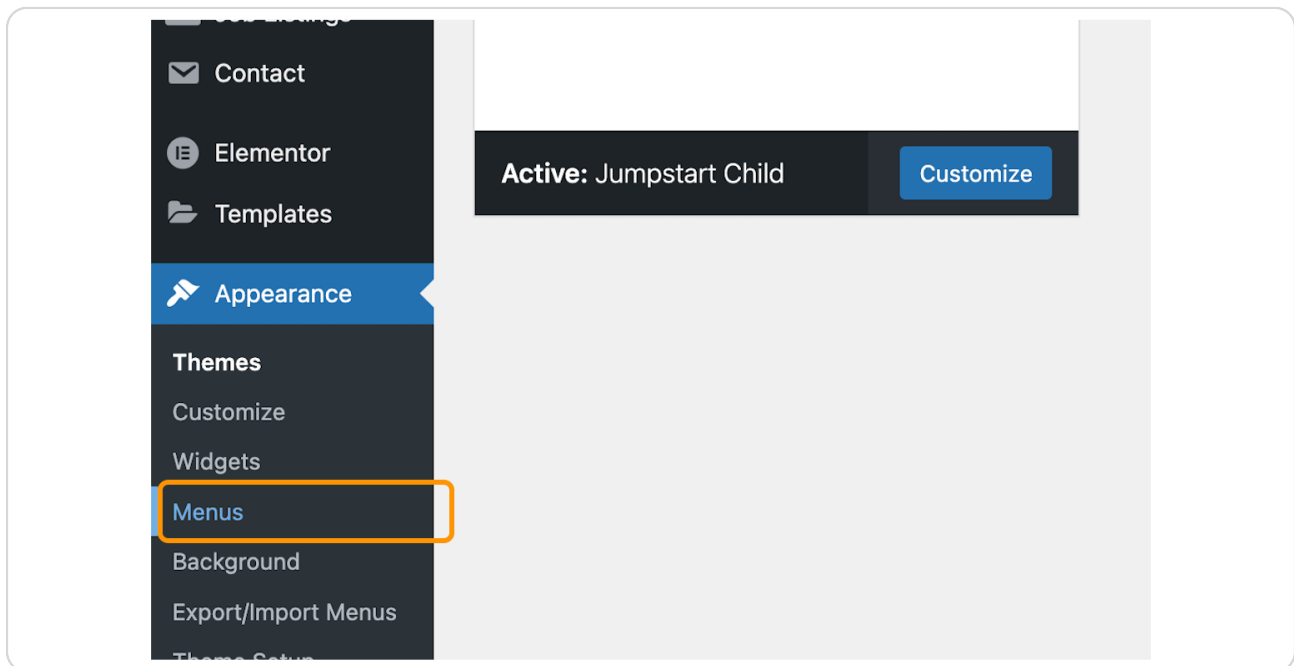
STEP 1

Click on Appearance on your WordPress Dashboard, left hand menu



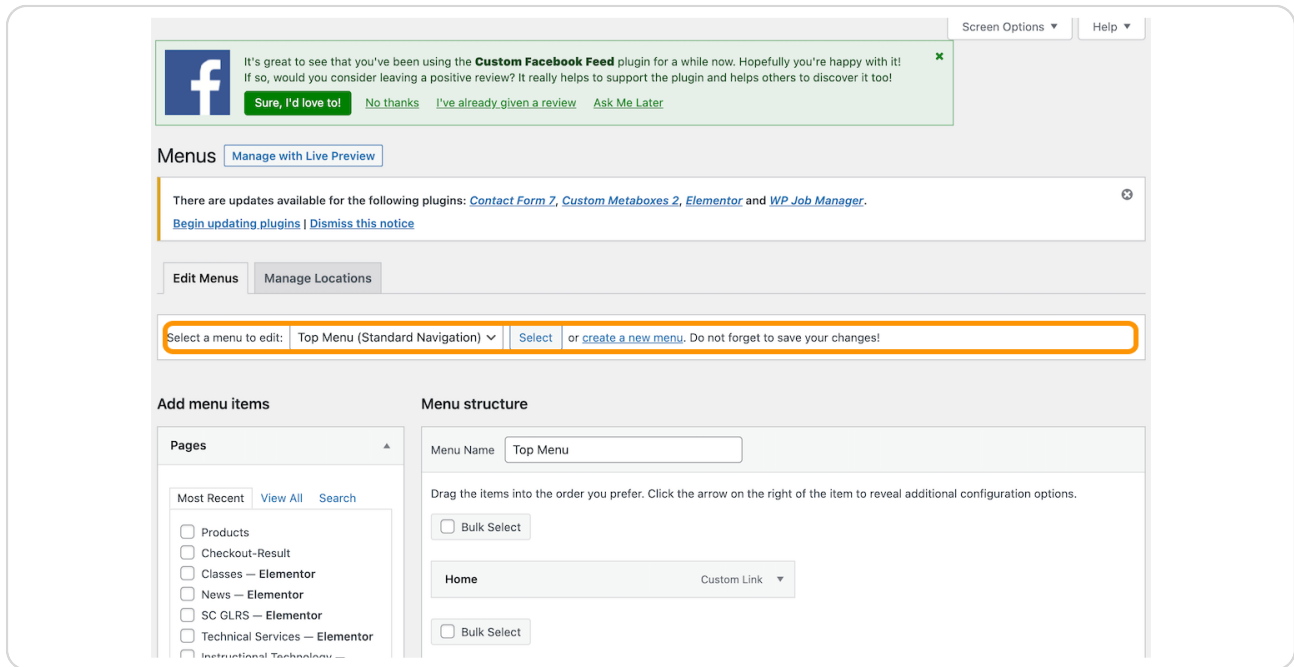
STEP 2

Click on Menus



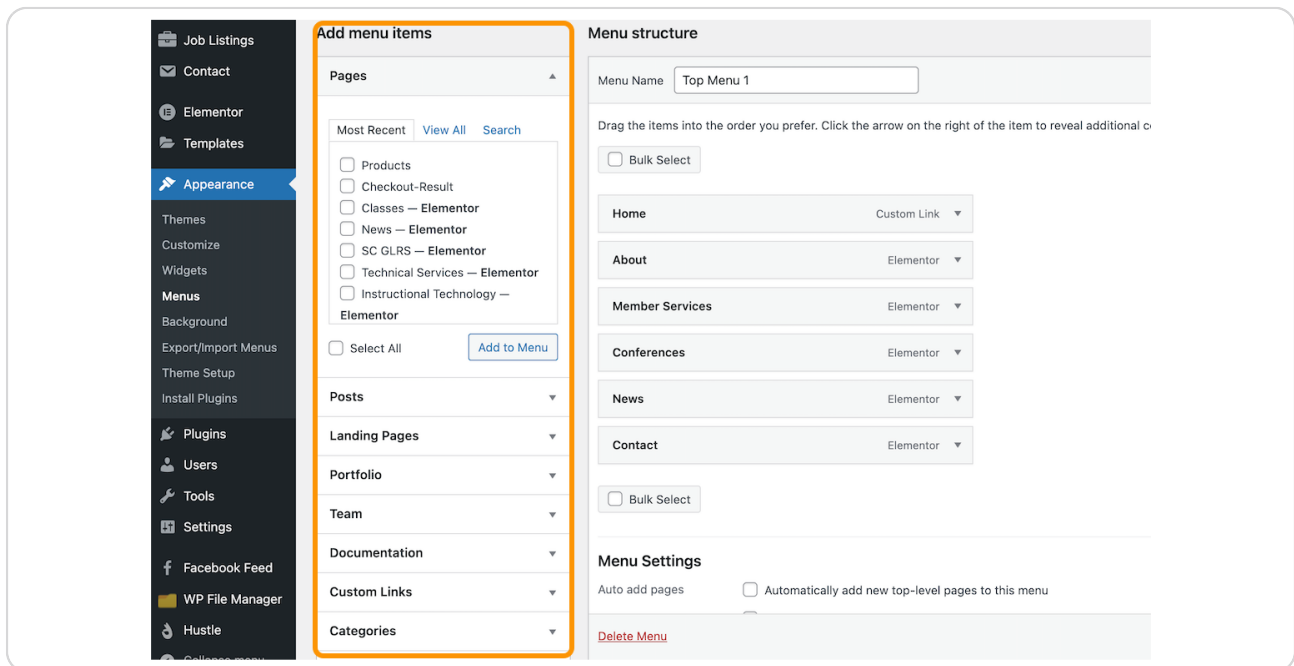
STEP 3

Ensure the correct menu is selected at the top



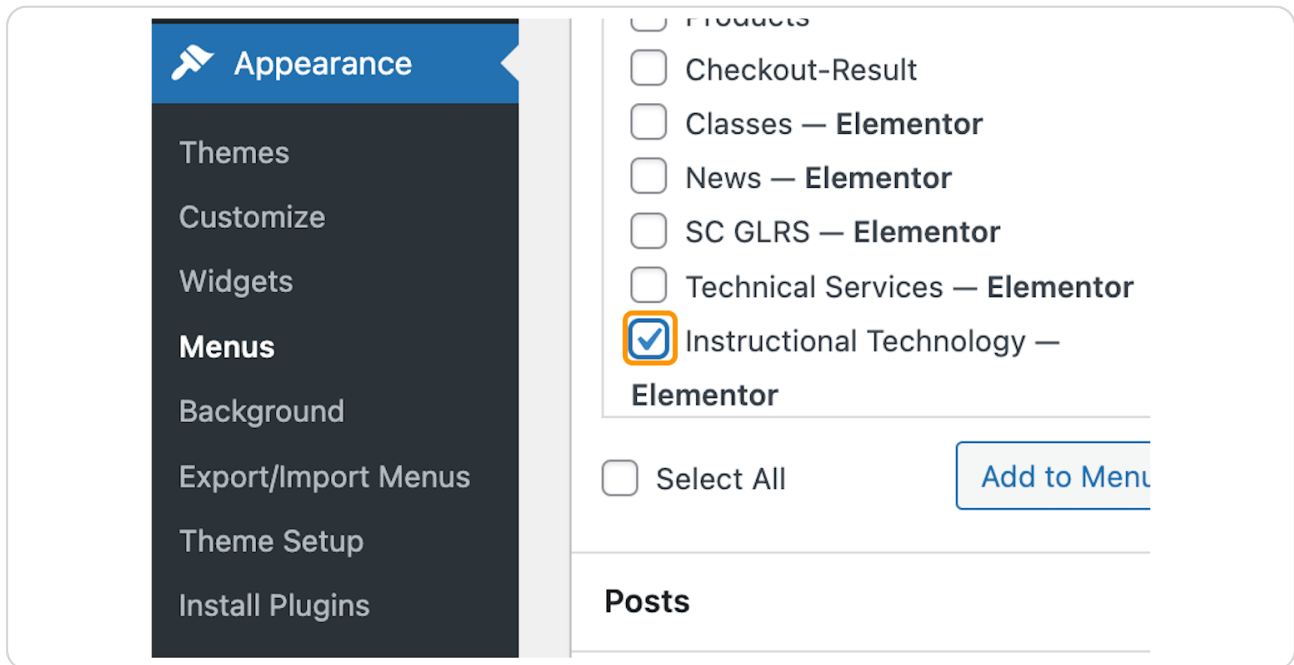
STEP 4

On the left hand side, you have your options of what to add



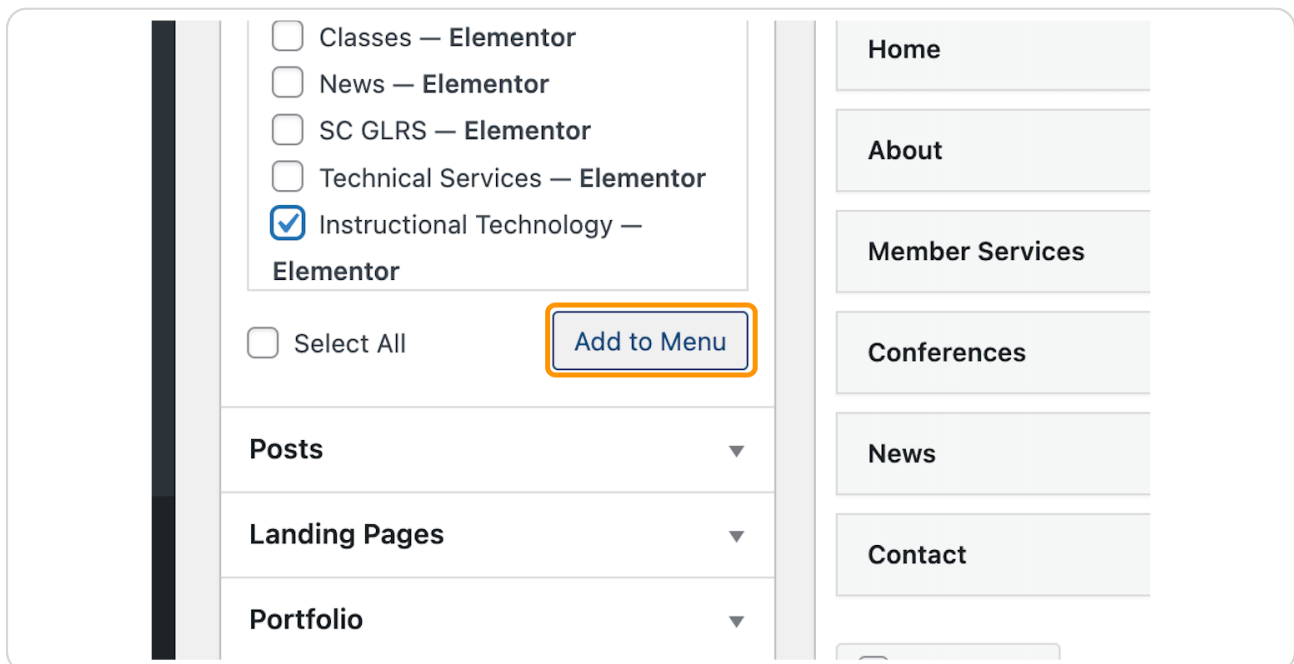
STEP 5

We'll use a Page to add to the menu, click the checkbox to select it




STEP 6
