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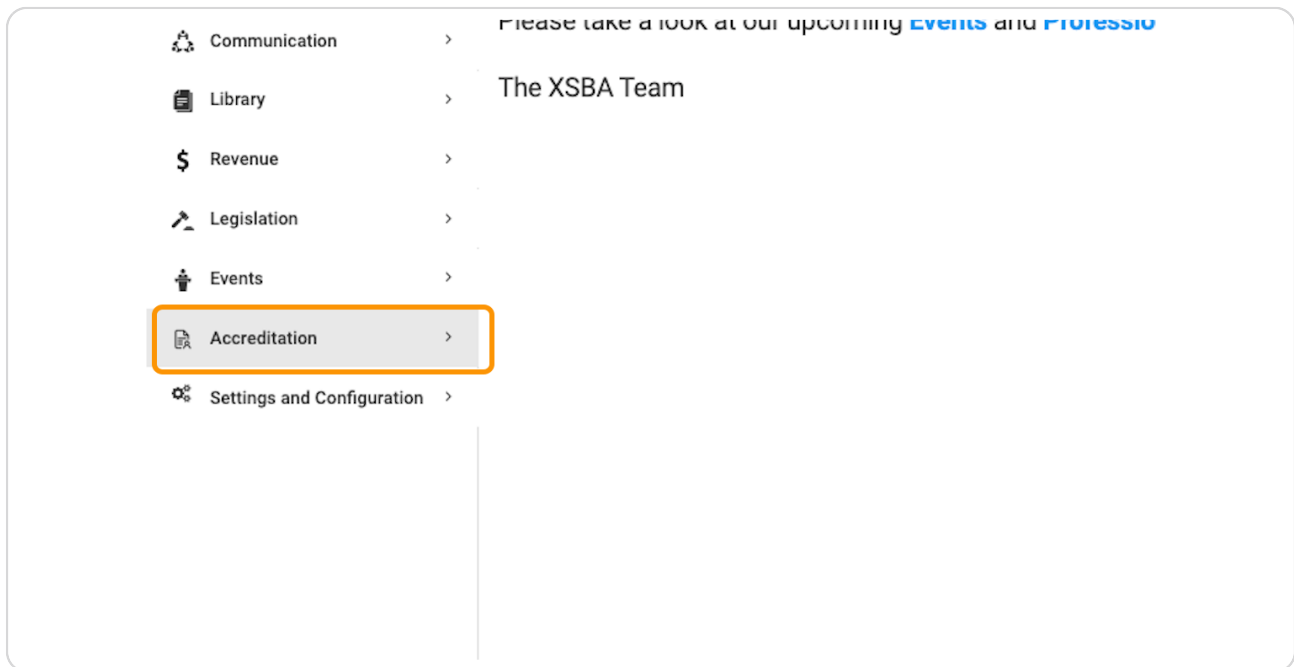
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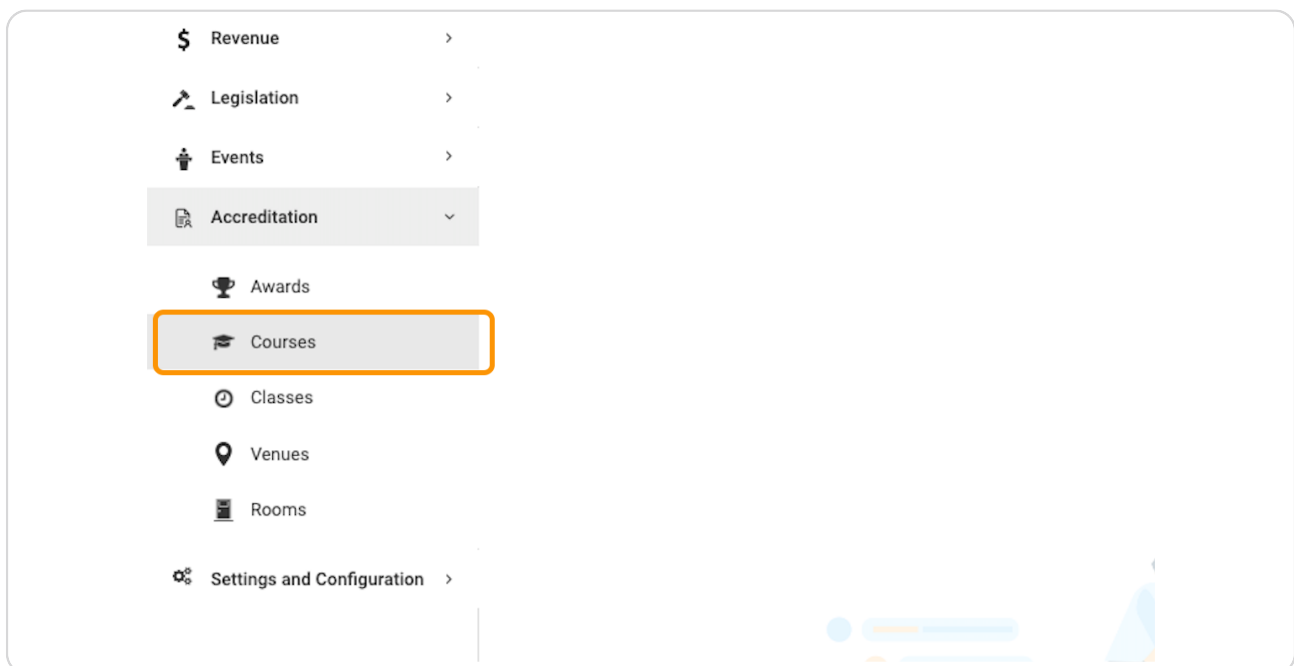
## STEP 1

### Click on Accreditation



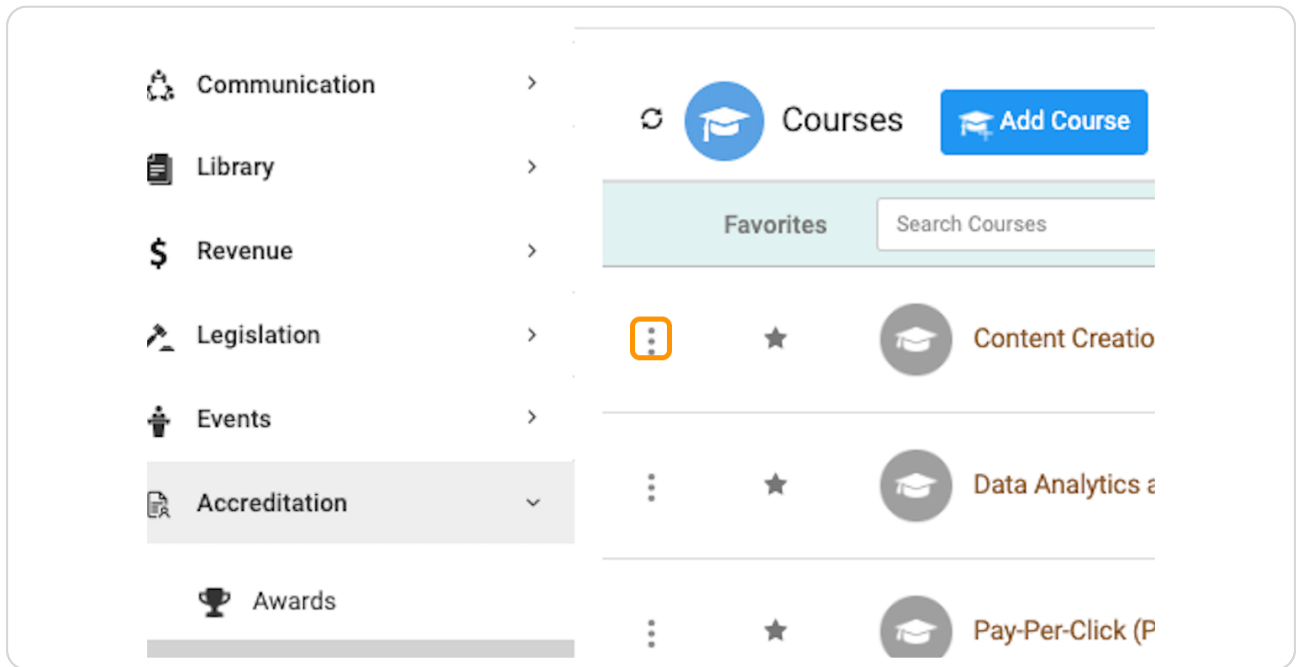

### Click on Courses



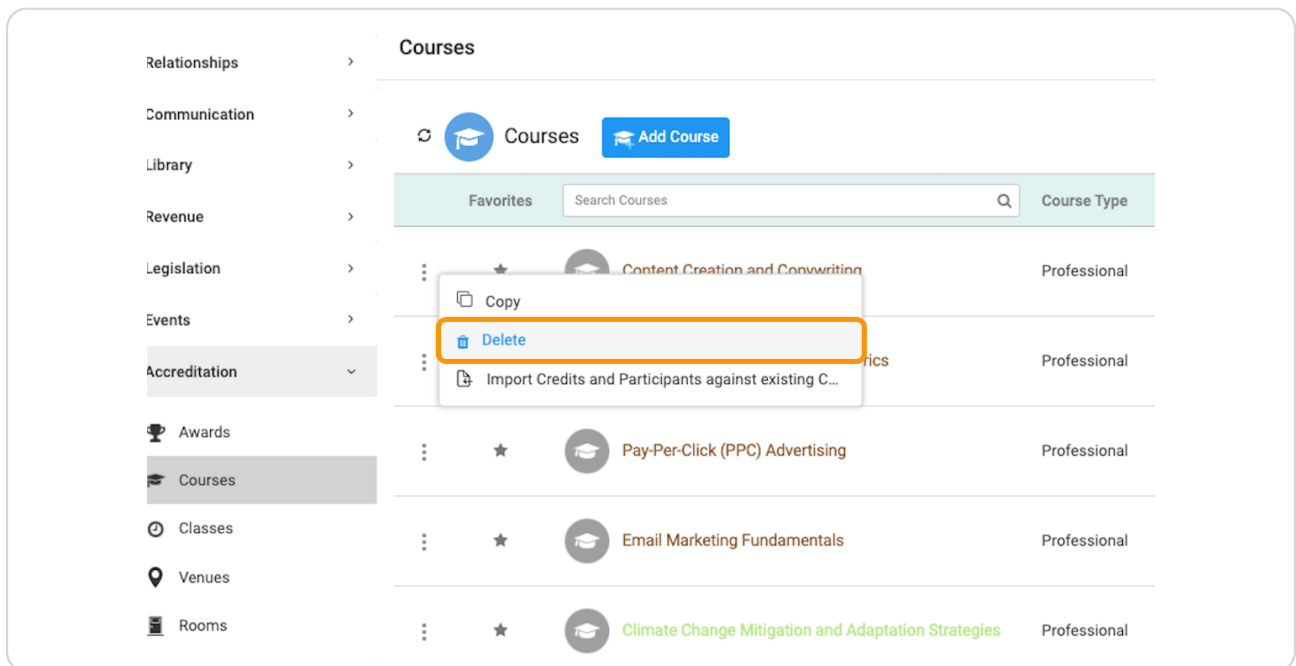
### STEP 3
