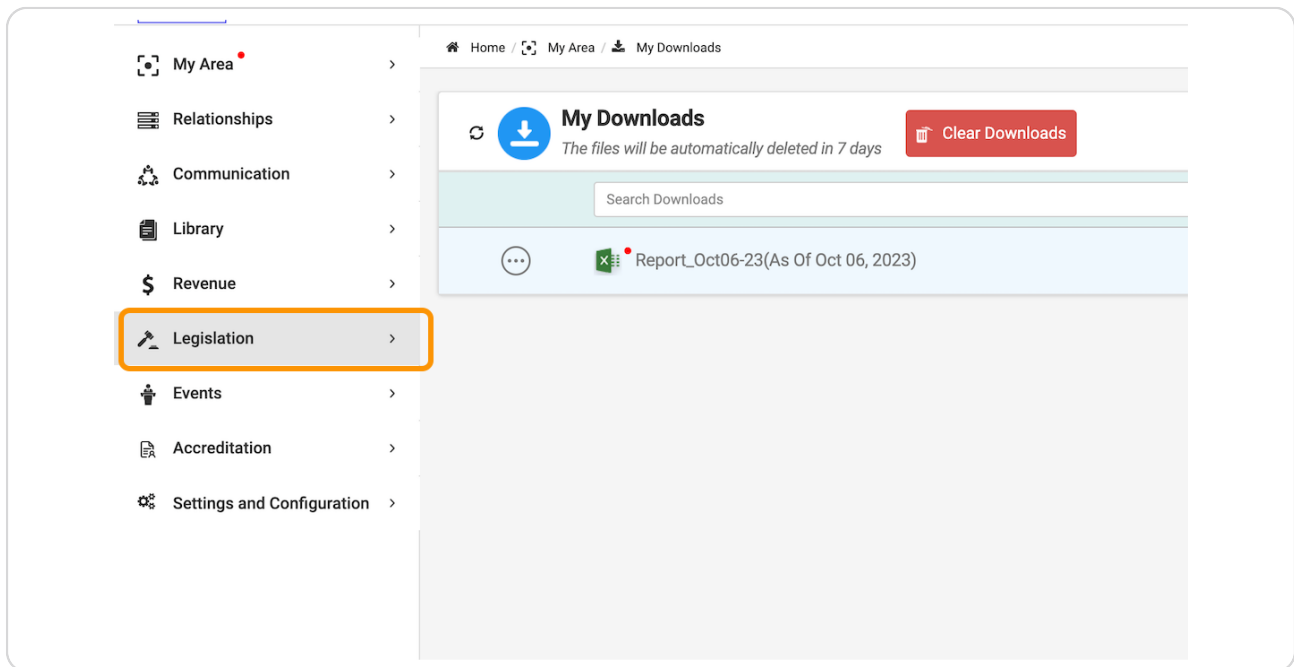

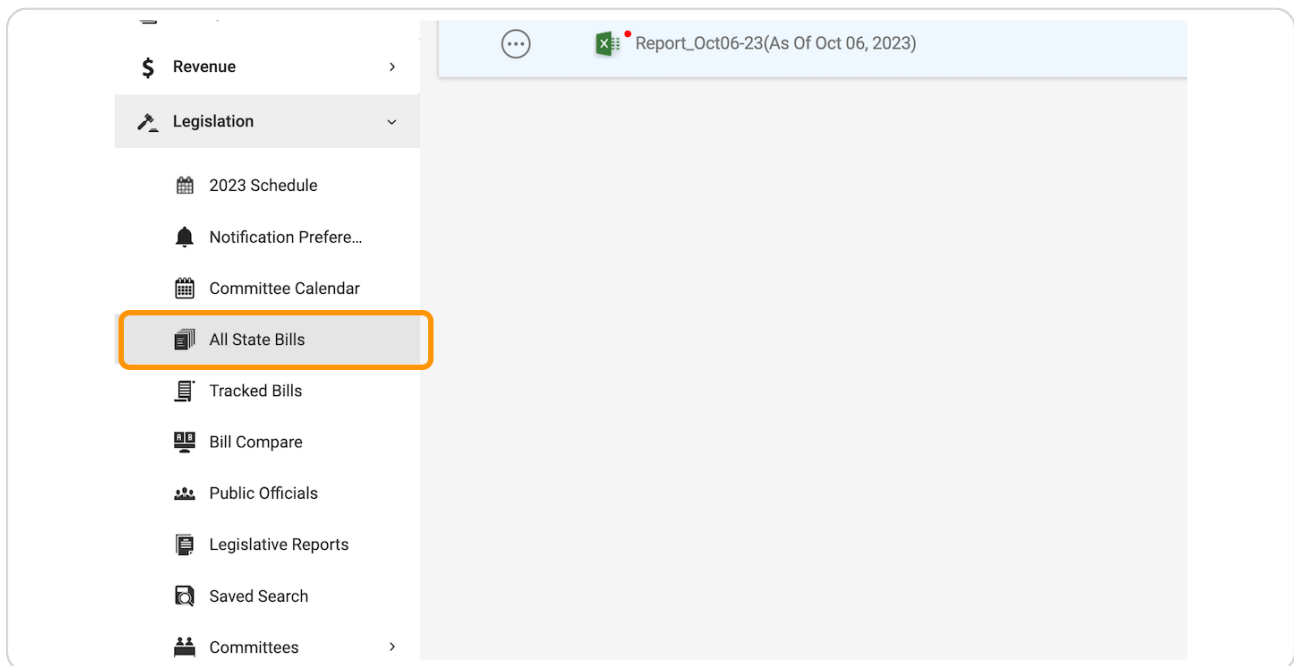
STEP 1

Click on Legislation



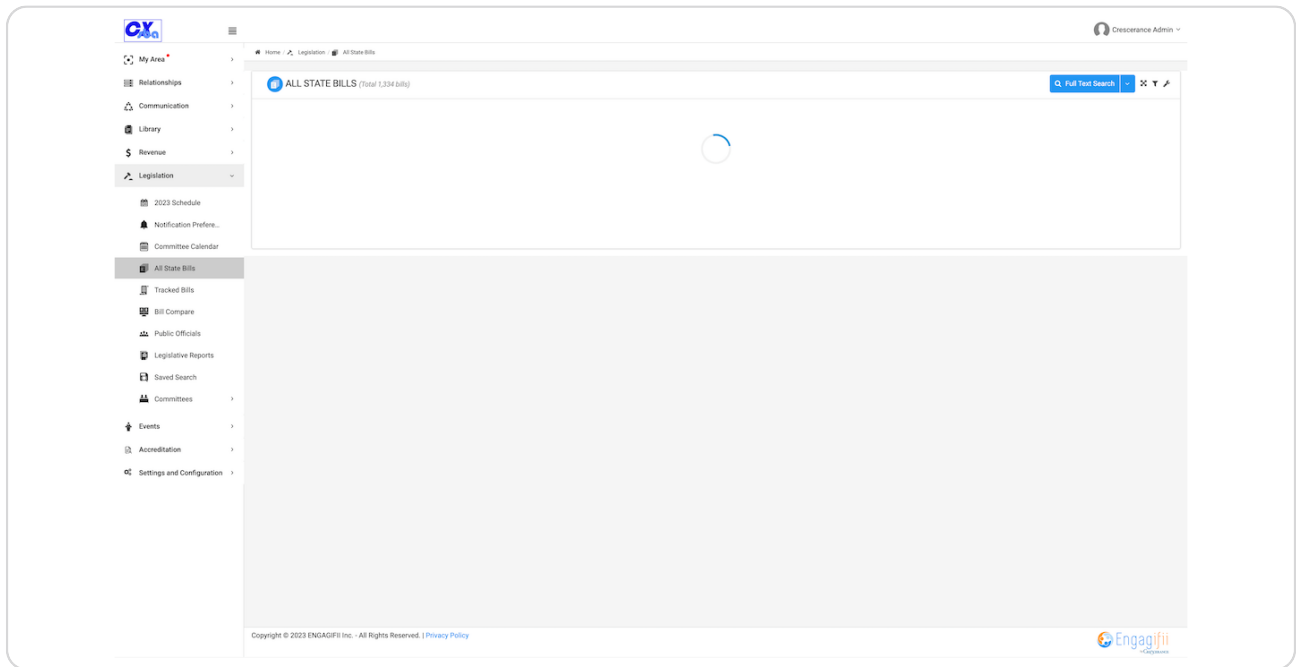
STEP 2

Click on All State Bills



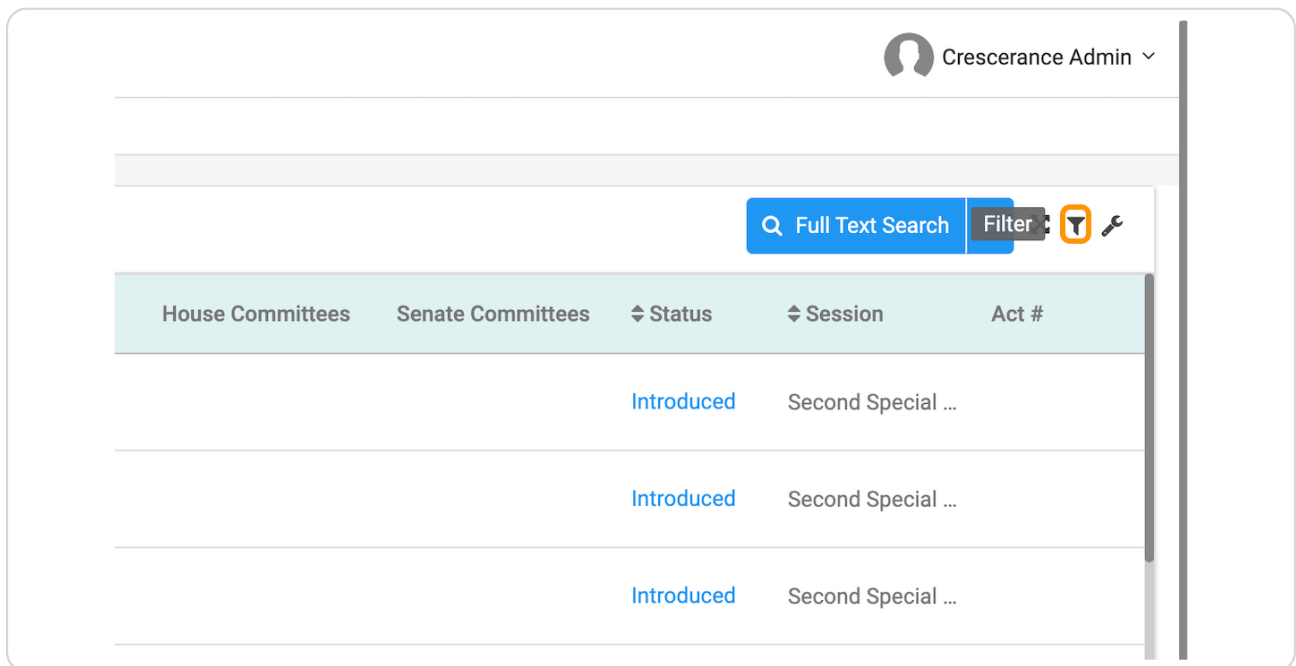
STEP 3

If you want to see bills on larger scale, Select the Value Count



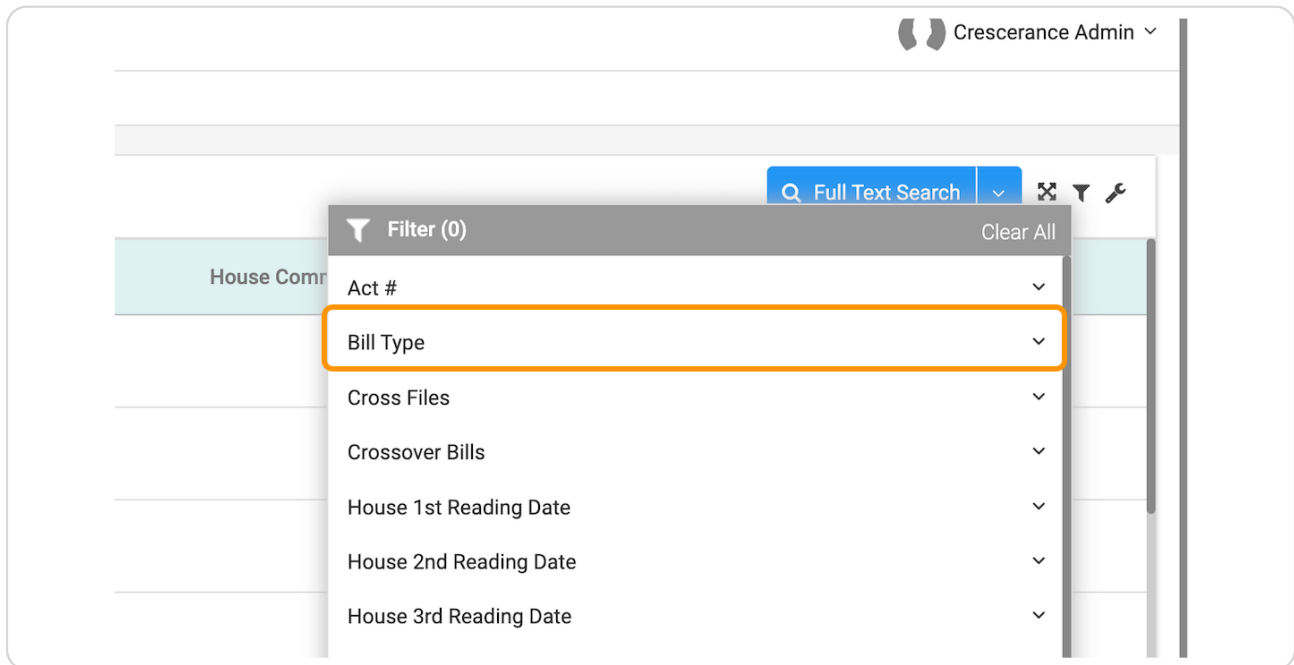
STEP 4

If you want to see specific bill category, Click on Filter



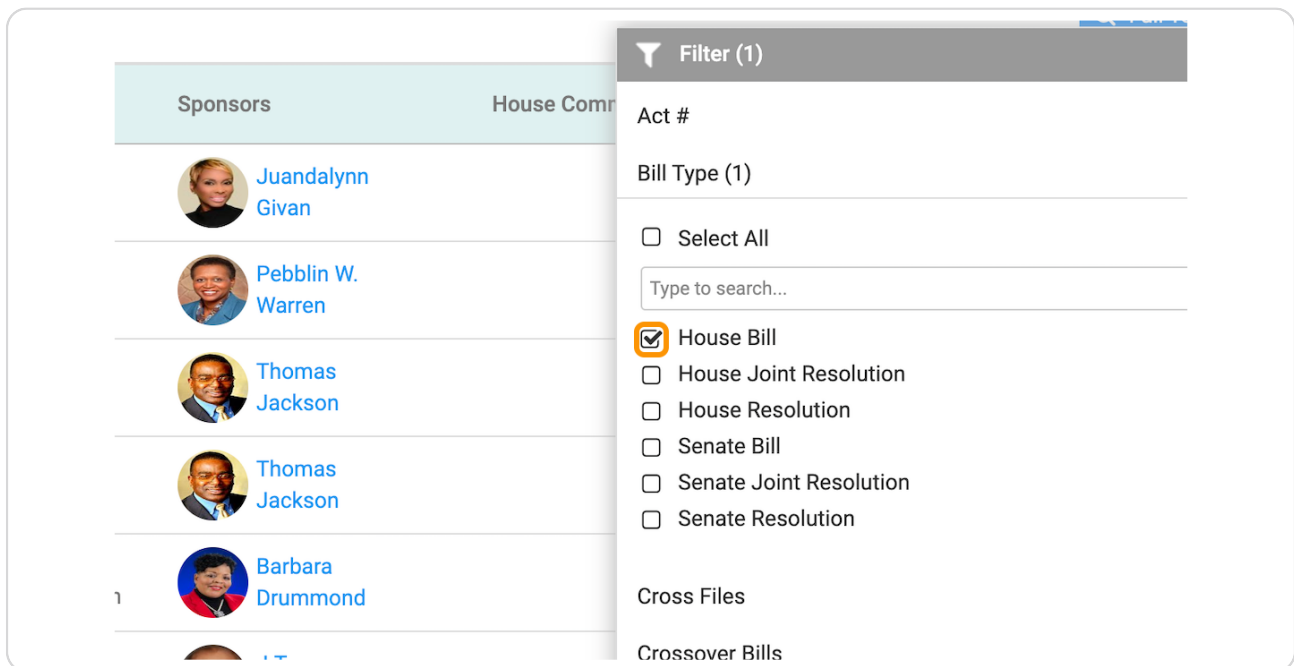
STEP 5




