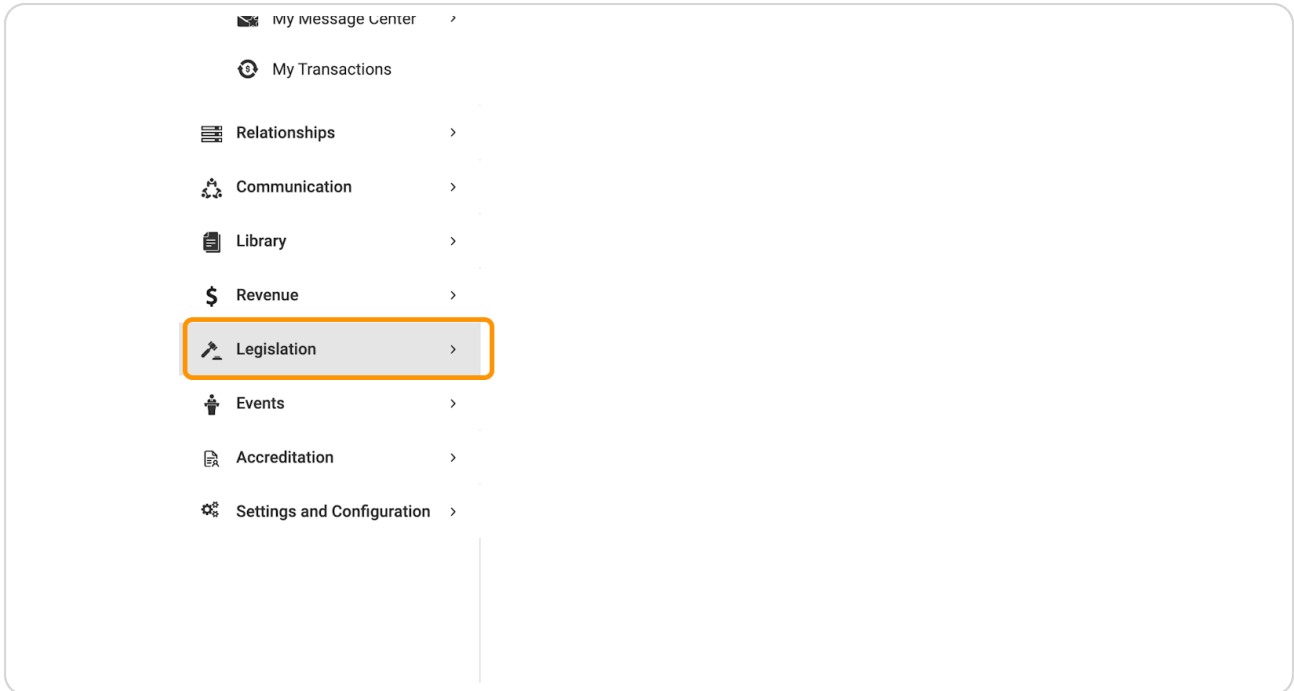

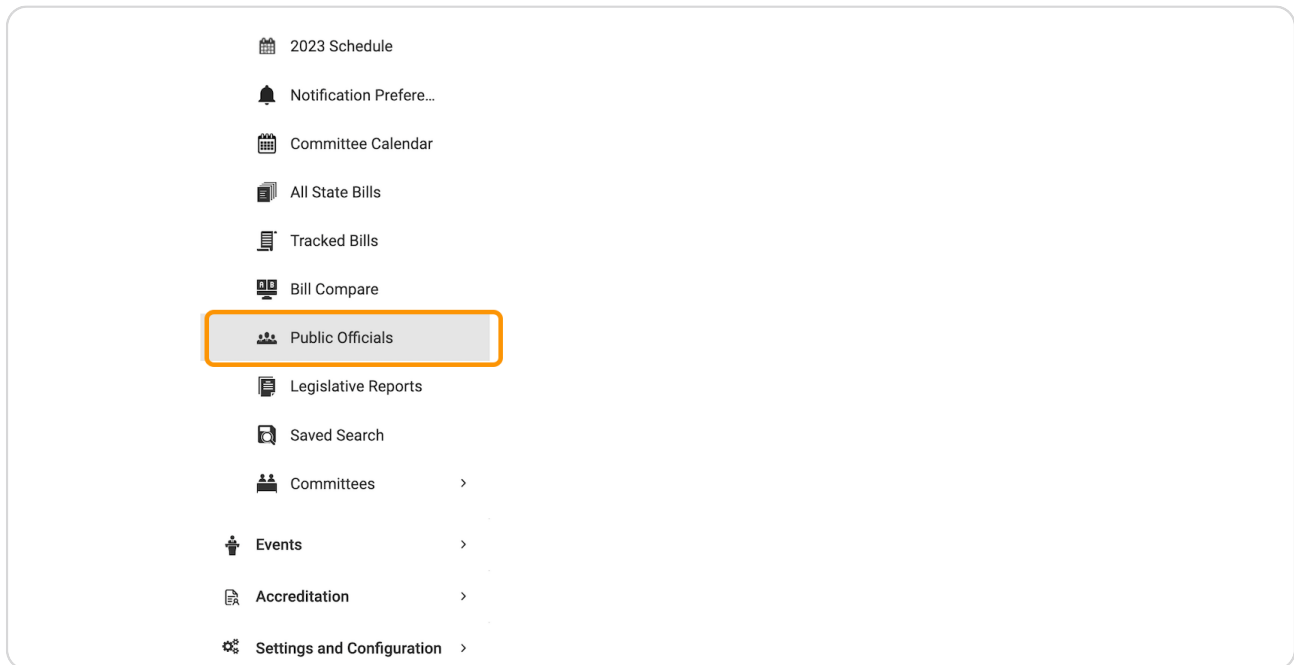
## STEP 1

### Click on Legislation



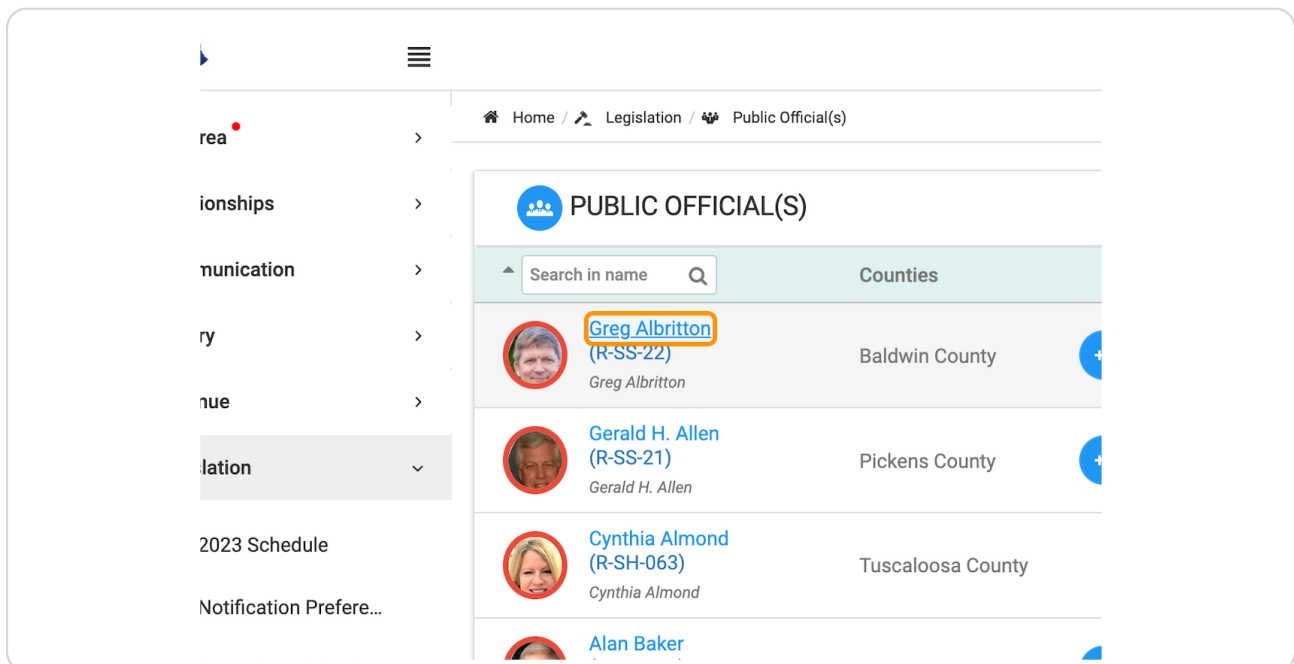
## STEP 2
